O-305: Type 3 All Hazards Incident Management Team Introduction Course

This 40-hour course will be offered in August and November to support local response capabilities. O-305 provides an overview of how incident management teams function during complex incidents and prepares participants for future position-specific training.

The course is academically rigorous and includes homework and post-class preparation. Participants may not miss more than 10% of the instruction (no more than 3.5 hours) to receive a certificate. Students will be required to bring a laptop, tablet, or suitable device to access online testing links and conduct assigned presentations. 
