Orthopedic Lab - Common Fracture Repair Surgery

Instructors: Brian Beale, DVM, DACVS & Don Hulse, DVM, DACVS

General practitioners are now able to successfully repair a variety of fractures in dogs and cats with a good outcome and few complications. Locking plates will be used to repair fractures of the radius, femur and tibia using saw bone models. Fracture repair is fun and will give you a new skill set to jump start your career and give you another source of revenue. This course will teach you the essential principles to repair simple and comminuted fractures. The techniques learned in this lab are an important stepping-stone to other procedures such as TPLO.

Orthopedic Lab – Common Joint Repair Surgery

Joint instability is a common problem that can be the result of trauma or developmental abnormality. This course will use a variety of implants to return stability to joints of the hindlimb. The course begins by treating the most common cause of hindlimb lameness in dogs - CCL tears and MPL. Hip dislocation will also be treated using a toggle rod stabilization. Lastly participants will learn how to perform a proper FHO.
